Business Recovery Grant program. The program provides a payment to eligible North Carolina businesses that experia significant economic loss due to pandemic. application for Phase 2 of the Business Recovery Grant program will be open from May 2, 2022 to June 1, 2022. Many business owners that did not qualify in Phase 1 are now eligible to apply in Phase 2.

North Carolina provides many services to small businesses through NCWorks, community college small business centers, the N.C. Small Business and Technology Development Center, the Veterans Business Outreach Center, the Rural Center and a tollfree information and referral service known as the Small Business Advisors hotline.
