Statewide Developmental Disabilities Council Launches Virtual Road Tour to "Meet" Communities

Starting Monday, May 11, the North Carolina Council on Developmental Disabilities (NCCDD) hit the virtual road to gather input from individuals with intellectual or other developmental disabilities (I/DD), family members, caregivers and other stakeholders.

The Conversations with the Council - Virtual Road Tour will help the Council to begin building its Five-Year State Plan (5YSP) process by gathering input from the disability community to create goals for the 2022-2026 5YSP (October 1, 2021 - September 30, 2026). The Five-Year State Plan is the Council's blueprint for creating a better North Carolina for individuals with I/DD.

NCCDD will host two sessions per region. Anson County is in the Piedmont Region, and is scheduled as follows:

Piedmont Region: Monday, May 18 12:30 p.m. - 2:00 p.m. & 6:30 p.m. - 8:00 p.m.
