

Union Drug Store

I am sure that not many people, even those around the Marshville area, remember the Union Drug Store that was near the "square in downtown."

Phil Gaddy was owner and pharmacist, and he had completed the remodeling except for signs. I did the new metal letters from "scratch." I made the patterns, cut the metal, assembled them, painted them white and then installed them. Then I put gold leaf on every window (on the top half of the windows), including glass on the west side with "Union Drug Store." On the front upper glass (in gold leaf also) were symbols with the mortar and pestle - along with other symbols

relating to the prescription drug business. The lighting in the picture does not show up the gold leaf at its best.

I always thought it looked "real good," especially for my many "trips - up and down the ladder." On the gold leaf there was a minimum of four trips up and down every few inches for layout, signing, and then leaf and varnish.

Today the gold leaf alone would cost more than my complete job. I did this job and took the picture on March 20, 1970.

Note the 1969 Chevrolet Suburban parked in front of the store - it goes back some years also. It, too, was sharp!

2017 Ag Cost Share Funding Available

The major cause of water quality problems in North Carolina and in much of the United States is nonpoint source pollution. In many cases, damage to our water resources comes from soil erosion, excessive fertilizer use, animal waste contamination, and improper use of agricultural chemicals.

The North Carolina Agricultural Cost Share Program helps to address nonpoint source pollution by providing technical and financial assistance to landowners.

Some services include pasture improvements, waste/mortality management, stream protection, and many more practices to help protect soil erosion and water quality in agriculture operations.

If you are a landowner or renter of an agriculture operation that has been operating for three years or longer, then you are eligible to participate in the NC Ag Cost Share Program. Anson County has been allocated \$73,278 in funds for fiscal year 2017.

To apply for cost share, please come to Brown Creek Soil and Water Conservation District office, located at 1758 Morven Road in Wadesboro (the USDA Building) or contact Resource Conservationist Jake Barbee to make arrangements to apply 704-694-3516 ext.3.
