BOARD OF ELECTIONS SEEKING POLL WORKER APPLICATIONS FOR UPCOMING ELECTIONS

Submitted by the Anson County Board of Elections

On August 18th, 2015 based on North Carolina General Statute 163-41, the Anson County Board of Elections upon recommendations of County Political Party Chairs will appoint Chief Judges and Judges for a 2 year term. These individuals will serve as precinct officials at the precinct that they reside in.

Interested citizens who would like to serve as a poll worker are asked to complete a poll worker application to the Anson County Board of Elections (Attention: Director Steve Adams). After review of applications to ensure residency and active voter status, Adams will forward all applications to each political party chair for review and recommendations.

Qualifications:

- Must be a registered voter
- Must be a resident of the county in which the precinct is located
- Must not be an elected government official or a manager or treasurer for any candidate or political party
- Must not be a candidate in the election

How Appointed:

Precinct officials can be recommended by the political parties and are appointed by the Anson County Board of Elections for a two (2) year term beginning in August of odd numbered years

Poll workers are compensated for their service to the election process. Also, North Carolina General Statute gives those employed the right to serve on election day...

§ 163-41.2. Discharge of precinct official unlawful.
(a) No employer may discharge or demote any employee because appointed as a precinct official and is serving as a precinct official.

Selected poll workers must attend mandatory trainings and pre election set up of polling site.
