

Free Groceries Available to Eligible Families this Saturday

The Burnsville Recreation & Learning Center (BRLC) Emergency Food Pantry will distribute free food products this Saturday, May 27 at 10 a.m. These foods are provided by the NC Department of Agriculture through the Second Harvest Food Bank of Metrolina. Families will be served until the food runs out - first come, first served.

The US federal income guidelines will be a determining factor for each individual's eligibility and food items will only be available to Ansonians who qualify. Individuals who have not registered before nor received food from the BRLC Emergency Food Pantry must have financial documentation as proof of income to be served. A neighbor who does not have the necessary documentations will not be served. Families that receive food stamp assistance automatically qualify. Each family will only be provided these commodities this month. Parents are asked not to bring small children. Neighbors, please park in parking lot behind center.

BRLC distributes free groceries to eligible families on Wednesdays at 9 a.m. and at other times. You can contact them at 704-826-8182 for information. BRLC is located at 13349 Highway 742 North in Burnsville, across from the Fire Department.

Think You May be Eligible for WIC?

WIC is a nutritional supplemental program for pregnant, postpartum, or breastfeeding women, infants and children under 5 years of age. To be eligible for WIC you must live in North Carolina.

If you receive Medicaid, Work First Families Assistance, or SNAP you automatically meet the income eligibility requirements.

A family may be eligible for WIC based on your household income, even if you do NOT receive Medicaid, Work First Families Assistance, or SNAP. The following list are income guideline that went into effect June 1, 2016.

- Family of 1 - monthly income \$1,832 - weekly income \$423
- Family of 2 - monthly income \$2,470 - weekly income \$570
- Family of 3 - monthly income \$3,108 - weekly income \$718
- Family of 4 - monthly income \$3,747 - weekly income \$865
- Family of 5 - monthly income \$4,385 - weekly income \$1,012
- Family of 6 - monthly income \$5,023 - weekly income \$1,160
- Family of 7 - monthly income \$5,663 - weekly income \$1,307
- Family of 8 - monthly income \$6,304 - weekly income \$1,455

For a family size greater than 8 please call the office for income information. For income based on annual, bi-weekly or twice a month please call the office. The WIC office is located at 110 Ashe Street in Wadesboro. The office phone number is 704-694-9844, and office hours are Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 12 noon and 1 to 5 p.m.
