

Aquarius Boutique Unlimited

Was "thumbing through" some of my "sign picture collection" and came across this picture that I had painted and installed on July 15, 1976 on this store building. This business, Aquarius Boutique, was on North Greene Street, between Fox & Lyon Drug Store and Belk's Department Store. Its building was destroyed along with the Lyon Building and Woods building in a fire on January 4, 1983. Some of the businesses affected by the fire were Woods 5&10, E.H. Jones Jewelry and Becky's Dress Shop.

Aquarius Boutique was located in the old A&P building where I had my first job (1939) working on Saturday, from 7:30 a.m. until, sometimes, Sunday at 1:30 or 2 a.m. My salary was \$2 a day less 2¢ for Social Security. You see the store had to be cleaned up, restocked and ready to open on Monday morning for the customers. There was no such thing as being open on Sundays back in "those days," and you know what - "we still existed" - didn't even go hungry!

Things do change, however - Allen and I are "still eating," at least some of the time!! Many thanks for reading! Ed
