Mr. Henry Allen Snuggs, 76, died peacefully on Wednesday, June 3, 2020, at Hospice Haven in Rockingham.

A memorial service was held on Saturday, June 6, 2020, in the Chapel of Leavitt Funeral Home with Rev. Dr. Harry Workman officiating. Inurnment followed in Eastview Cemetery.

Because Allen was a simple man, the family requested causal attire for those who planned to attend the service.

Allen was born March 23, 1944, in Anson County, and was a son of the late George Baker Snuggs and the late Nancy Chambers Allen Snuggs.
