


Krista Herold Earns **Honored Educator Scholarship**

Krista Herold, a kindergarten teacher at Peachland-Polkton Elementary School, was honored on Friday, June 14th at the "Old Fossil" Golf Tournament in Southern Pines. The tournament benefits the A. Craig Phillips Honored Educator Scholarship, named after the former State Superintendent of North Carolina from 1968-1988. Herold received the A. Craig Phillips Honored Educator Scholarship on September 27, 2012, at the NC Center for the Advancement of Teaching (NCCAT).

Each year, the scholarship provides for two kindergarten teachers from NC to attend an NCCAT seminar of choice. The scholarship covers all costs associated with the teacher's participation in a five-day seminar including program materials, instruction, travel, food, and lodging, as well as

paying for the substitute teacher while the scholar is at NCCAT. The teacher also receives \$250 for use in the classroom. Herold attended the seminar entitled "Integrating the Arts Across the Curriculum" in Cullowhee, NC, from September 23-27. She used the \$250 to purchase two Nooks (electronic e-readers) for her classroom.




