Deborah Noel Of UNC TV to Visit the HOLLA! Center

Holla has announced that UNC TV will visit the Holla Center on June 29 and 30 for the purpose of taping a documentary on the impact of the organization and the Holla Community Resource and Development Center on the local community. Deborah Noel, the host of Black Issues Forum for UNC TV, said that she is interested in this project because it has been around almost seven years, is working and seems like it can be reproduced.

Holla officials say that Mrs. Noel and the camera crew intend to arrive in Anson County on the afternoon of Wednesday, June 29 and stay until the afternoon of Thursday, June 30. She intends to interview the mayor, a select group of parents, teachers, students and others wishing to discuss the impact and potential of the center. "She has high interest in the summer camp," said Alexander Gaddy, the Activities Director for the Holla Center. "We hope that this positive exposure will blaze trails for the paths of more things to come into our community for the benefit our youth," said Leon Gatewood, CEO of Holla.
