## From the Sheriff's Desk

Identity Theft has been a hot topic for the past few years and continues to be today, maybe more so than ever. The Federal Trade Commission estimates that as many as nine million citizens will have their identities stolen each year. It's likely that you or someone you know will have experienced some form of identity theft.

The crime takes many forms. Identity thieves may rent an apartment, obtain a credit card, or establish a telephone account in your name. You may not find out about the theft until you review your credit report; or a credit card or billing statement; or be contacted by a debt collector. Victims will spend many hours on the phone with creditors or companies; and may have to even hire an attorney to help clean up the mess.

While you may not be able to prevent identity theft entirely, you can minimize your risk by

 Install strong passwords on your credit cards, bank and phone accounts. Avoid passwords like your mother's maiden name, birthdate, last four letters of your social security number or phone number. Protect your statements. Keep them or destroy them with a shredder. Don't put them in the trash. Pay attention to billing cycles. Look closely at what has been billed to your accounts. Look for any changes to your accounts.

 Have Social Security checks and other recurring checks deposited directly into your account. Never give out information about your bank account or credit card by phone. Companies and banks will not call asking for personal information.

 Minimize the amount of identification information you carry around. Never carry your Social Security card with you.

• Keep personal information in a safe place. Shred credit offers, expired cards, check, statements, etc. If you become a victim, report the incident immediately to your local law enforcement agency. A police report is usual necessary for the banks or credit card companies to take any corrective action. It's usual not an easy, quick fix as often the thief resides in other states or even other countries. ### Wildlife Commission Announces July 4 as Free Fishing Day

Fishing for a fun and inexpensive way to celebrate Independence Day? The NC. Wildlife Resources Commission invites anglers and would-be anglers of all ages to go fishing - for free. On July 4 from  $12{:}01$  a.m. until  $11{:}59$  p.m., everyone in North Carolina - resident and nonresidents alike - can fish in any public body of water, including coastal waters, without purchasing a fishing license or additional trout fishing privilege. Although no fishing license is required, all other fishing regulations, such as size and creel limits and lure restrictions, still apply.

To give anglers a better chance of catching fish, the Commission stocks a variety of fish in waters across the state - including trout and channel catfish. The agency also provides access to fishing sites across the state, including public fishing areas and boating access areas. The interactive fishing and boating maps on the Commission's website list more than 500 fishing and boating areas, many of which are free, that are open to the public.

Authorized by the NC. General Assembly and started in 1994, North Carolina's annual free fishing day always falls on July 4.

On all other days of the year, a fishing license is not required for anglers 15 years and younger, but anyone age 16 and older must have a fishing license to fish in any public water in North Carolina, including coastal waters. To purchase a license:


# "Agriculture Adventures" Summer Camp Offered by Anson County Cooperative Extension
