### **Local Veteran Receives Special Gift in Honor of His Service**

The 9th District Commander, Mr. Anthony Hall presented him with a special gift that had been sent by him from Mr. Thomas A. Pouliot who is a National Past Commander-In-Chief of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States

Mr. Pouliot served as Commander-In-Chief from 1998-1999. He was an invited guest of the North Carolina VFW's Annual Convention that was held in Raleigh. While at the convention it was brought to Mr. Pouliot's attention that Anson County's VFW Post 10403 had an authentic Buffalo Soldier as part of its membership. Mr. Pouliot is a resident of Helena, Montana who had driven with his wife to attend the convention. While on his way to the convention he stopped at Fort Huachuca, Arizona and became intrigued to find out that Fort Huachuca was the home of the original Buffalo Soldiers of the United States Army. While there he purchased a Buffalo




Soldiers Blanket as a souvenir of his visit. Unknowingly to him he would be made aware of Mr. Harris and he was compelled to send it by Mr. Hall to present it to him. While speaking with him on the phone, he said that he was honored to be able to present the blanket to someone who was such a part of a distinguished history of our great Nation. He also personally signed a picture of the Buffalo Soldiers Monument to be presented to Mr Harris also.

John Lester Harris enlisted in the United States Army on August 31, 1942, and served in the European Theater of Operations from September 20, 1944 until January 16, 1946.

He was assigned to Battery B 599th Field Artillery with the 92nd Division as a Radio Operator (776) and attained the rank of TEC/5. served valiantly on the front American Theater Service Medal, The EAME Service Good Conduct Medal and World War II Victory Medal.

His combat experience has taken a toll on his body with partially hearing loss and leg injury, but Mr, Harris has continued to his country and community in many areas. He currently is a member and senior deacon at Henry
