July Information

July is named after Roman dictator Julius Caesar (100 B.C.-44 B.C.). Caesar developed the precursor to the Gregorian calendar we use today

• July 3 brings the start of the hot and sultry Dog Days of Summer! "Dog Days are approaching; you must, therefore, make both hay and haste while the Sun shines, for when old Sirius takes command of the weather, he is such an unsteady, crazy dog, there is no dependence upon him." - The Old Farmer's Almanac, 1817

The "Dog Days" of summer last from July 3 to August 11. In ancient Greece and Rome, the Dog Days were believed to be a time of drought, bad luck, and unrest, when dogs and men alike would be driven mad by the extreme heat! Today, the phrase doesn't conjure up such bad imagery. Instead, the Dog Days are associated purely with the time of summer's peak temperatures and humidity.

Sirius is the brightest star in the sky, if you don't count our own Sun. Under the right conditions, it can even be seen with the naked eye during the day. Sirius is one star in a group of stars that form the constellation Canis Major, meaning "Greater Dog." It's no surprise, then, that the nickname of this big, bold star Sirius became "the Dog Star."

• July 4 is Independence Day (U.S.). On the fourth of July, we celebrate the adoption of the Declaration of Independence in 1776. Don't forget to raise the flag! What this holiday commemorates is the adoption of the Declaration of Independence on July 4, 1776, by delegates from the 13 colonies. On the 4th the Continental Congress approved the final wording of the Declaration of Independence. This is the day we celebrate the birth of the United States of America.
