After several hit-or-miss years, peach growers across the state are celebrating what is shaping up to be a solid peach growing season.

'Consumers can expect peaches to be in good quantity and quality this year,

said Agriculture Commissioner Steve Troxler. "Many growers began picking in early June with plans to continue through the end of August." Unlike surrounding states, most

of North Carolina's peaches are sold directly to consumers at roadside stands and farmers markets. In fact, consumers can find peach orchards in about twothirds of the state's counties.


