This one dates back "just a few days!!" After retiring from operating the Taste Freeze, Jake Hanna leased his building to Bud Horne to become Bud's 24 Hour Restaurant. This was located on Highway 74/52 where Anson Bank now has an ATM machine. The highway, being new then, had little or none of the present business places as they are today. In fact, for a time Jake's Freeze and Royal Tire were the only places there, otherwise it was trees and red mud only!!

Bud and wife Myra did a good job for many years. One experience, however, comes to my mind as special! Our local telephone company was growing and changing - this time from North Carolina Telephone Company to Mid-Carolina Telephone Company, and this necessitated additional training for all the office personnel. Wanda Parker was sent Wadesboro as a company trainer in the new methods/usages in the service order system.

Early on the girls in the office tried to encourage my son Tommy McBride to ask Wanda out to lunch, failing on the first day, but succeeding on the second day. Wanda, I think, remembers the menu and occasion to this day - "It was a bologna club sandwich at Bud's." It must have been a "real good" sandwich - they married June 3, 1979, and recently celebrated their 31st anniversary. They are both now retired from the telephone industry.

Both Bud and Myra are now deceased and there is no Bud's Restaurant. In fact, nothing along that stretch of highway would remind you of the yesterdays gone by.
