Superintendent Michael Freeman is very excited to report that we have started a major construction project at Anson High School. Mr. Freeman has been contacted by a number of community members expressing positive support about this project.

The project will address the following needs at AHS:

- Repair of water drainage issues associated with the track and football field
- Replace roofs on the ticket booth, weight room, and the stadium bathrooms
- Replace guttering system on buildings
- Repair outside appearance of buildings (painting, vinyl, spirit decals, etc.)
- Renovate inside of stadium bathrooms
- Replace the track
- Repair and replace designated fencing
- Repair, replace, and add concrete sidewalks in specific areas
- Landscaping enhancements
- Removal of trees providing greater visibility
- Preparing cleared land for future school use
- Asphalt repairs Electrical repairs
