Athletic Event Safety Protocol

Athletic Event Safety Protocol ANSON COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT (ACSD)

ACSD families: we are asking for your help in making sure that all Anson County Schools' athletic events are as safe and secure as possible. With that goal in mind, we will be tightening our security procedures at all home ACSD games beginning with our Fall of 2023 athletic events.

ENDORSED/EFFECTIVE 06.26.23

- · No elementary or middle school student(s) should be dropped off and left unattended.
- · All spectators are expected to be seated during the athletic event with the exception of trips to the
- · Law enforcement and ACSD staff will be on-site to address any potential disruptions that may occur.
- · Entrance procedures may include the use of walkthrough/handheld metal detectors. · Prohibited items include, but are not limited to:
 - o Weapons (including pocket knives), vapes, tobacco products, lighters, etc...
 - There will be no re-entry to any contest after exiting the athletic facility.
 - o The Anson County School District reserves the right to deny entry to any athletic event for any person who fails to comply with these procedures.

New Bag Procedures

Fans are encouraged not to bring any type of bags inside any Anson County Schools' athletic facilities. However, the following bags are permitted:

- Bags that are clear plastic, vinyl or PVC and do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12"
- Small clutch bags, with or without a handle or strap, that do not exceed 4.5" x 6.5" (approximately the size
- An exception will be made for medically necessary items after proper inspection. Diaper bags are permitted as long as the child is in attendance.
- · Any bag brought to the athletic event may be subject to search prior to entry into the athletic facility.

PARENTS: All Anson County Elementary School Students (K-6) will be provided one ticket for free admission to the Anson Bearcats vs. Central Pageland Game. This ticket may only be used by the student. School staff from each elementary school will be attending the game showing support. Middle School Football Players, Cheerleaders and Band Members will be admitted free if they are wearing their jersey/cheer uniform/instrument. Parks & Recreation Players will receive a ticket through their elementary school but can also enter with their jersey. Students must have an adult with them to enter the stadium!

Announcements will be made before the game inviting students on the track to lineup by school and then participate in a walk around the track showing support and cheering for our Bearcats. One adult may accompany each elementary student when they meet on the track. The adult may also walk the track with their child. Students will return to the stadium to sit with their family when the walk is complete.

Middle School Football and Cheer Teams and Parks & Rec Football Teams will also walk the track to be recognized. After the walk, the Middle School Football Team and Parks & Rec Football Teams will report to the goal post near the field house by 7:20 p.m. to run on the field with the varsity team at 7:30 p.m. Middle School Cheer will also report to the goal post at 7:20 p.m. to cheer as the team runs out. Middle School Band Members will have a special performance at halftime with our high school band!

We encourage adults to purchase tickets early to eliminate having to wait in line on game day. Unless you arrive extremely early, waiting to purchase tickets at the gate could result in the student not making it to the track in time for the walk.
