American Red Cross Water Safety Instructor Course

The American Red Cross, Stanly County Chapter, will offer the American Red Cross Instructor Safety Course. The purpose of the course is to train instructor candidates to teach water safety, including the Basic Water Rescue course, six levels of the Learn-to-Swim and Parent and Child Aquatics.

Participants must be at least 16 years of age by the last scheduled session of the instructor course and be able to demonstrate the following skills: Swim the following strokes consistent American Red Cross Learnto-Swim Level 4 Stroke Performance criteria:

- Front crawl—25 yards;
- Back crawl—25 yards;
- Breaststroke—25 yards; Elementary backstroke-25 yards; 5) Sidestroke—25
- yards; 6) Butterfly—15 yards; 7) Maintain position on back 1 minute in deep water (floating or sculling); and
- 8) Tread water for 1 minute. The course dates are: Thursday, August 25, 5 to 9 p.m.
- Friday, August 26, 9 a.m. to 8 p.m.
- Saturday, August 27, 9 a.m. to 8 p.m.
- Sunday, August 28, 1 to 8 p.m. The course location will
