AES Construct Solar Ovens in Third Grade

Students in 3rd grade received science lessons on energy and how it is transferred. To demonstrate this, students created solar ovens in small groups to make s'mores.

They learned that light from the sun enters the foil-lined box. The light energy from the sun is then converted to heat energy, which melts the chocolate. The foil helps reflect light so more light energy is transferred to the s'mores. The plastic wrap helps trap the heat inside.

All groups used the same materials to construct their solar ovens, but made slight modifications based on what they thought was necessary to produce the best results. At the conclusion of the activity, students got to enjoy their s'mores.
