1) Arrive at the bus stop five minutes early. 2) Stand five giant steps away from the curb.

3) Wait until the bus stops, the door opens, and the driver says it's okay before stepping

onto the bus. 4) Be sure the bus driver can always see you, and you can see the bus driver. For bus drivers The greatest risk to a child isn't riding a school bus but approaching or leaving one. Stay alert. Stay engaged. Keep them safe.

For the motoring public-1) See the school bus stop-arm? Time to STOP. Racing past the arm puts young lives in jeopardy. 2) School is in session! That means more children are outside waiting for the bus during certain hours. Slow down and watch for children playing and gathering near the bus stop.
