An avid outdoorsman, Richard's love for animals and nature started young. As a boy and teenager, he cared for various animals including snakes, raccoons, a fox, an alligator, and deer. He went on to obtain his taxidermy license and continued to hunt deer, turkeys, quail, ducks, and rabbits - a love that was passed down to his family. In more recent years, he was a strong supporter of Hands of a Sportsman and volunteered with the Anson County Hands of a Sportsman Youth Deer Hunt, which was first held at his cabin for youth and individuals with disabilities. This event has grown over the years to be one of the largest events in Anson County for young people.

He was a member of Peachland Baptist Church where he had served as a Sunday school teacher. He enjoyed a good golf game with his friends and was always kind, congenial, caring, and willing to help others in any way he could.
