

Town of Morven NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Morven Town Council will hold a public hearing to receive citizen input regarding submittal of a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Application to the NC Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR). The public hearing will be held on September 17, 2014, at 12 p.m. in the Morven Town Hall, 301 East Main Street, Morven, NC 28119. The public is invited to attend and comment. Written comments addressed to the Morven Town Council / Town of Morven P.O. Box 295, Morven, NC 28119, will be accepted prior to the hearings.

The Town of Morven is applying for CDBG Infrastructure funds to improve its wastewater collection system. The town proposes to:

- 1) Replace the 8" sewer force main (that transports the town's wastewater to the county for treatment) along US Highway 52 from the southern town limits to the northern town limits.
- 2) Extend a new gravity sewer main along Southern Avenue and a short section of Dunn Street to provide public sewer to some properties that are currently on septic tanks.
- 3) Repair existing gravity sewer mains and services on the east side of town (Moore Street, Cox Avenue, East Main Street, North Church Street, Depot Street, Martin Avenue and Dunn Street) These repairs will be completed using "trenchless methods" so as to minimize cutting and patching of roads.
- 4) Replace the gravity sewer main on US Highway 52 (South Wadesboro Street) from MH#55 going south to the town limits. The total project will include the installation of approximately 15,900 linear feet of functioning sewer line.

The town will apply for \$1,672,550 in CDBG funding from DENR which will primarily benefit persons having low-to-moderate income. The project will be 100% CDBG funded.

All interested persons are invited to attend this hearing. Auxiliary aids will be supplied to the disabled if requested five days prior to the public hearing.
