# North Carolina And Georgia **Plan First Air Mobility Corridor**

Charlotte-Atlanta route to test next-generation aircraft

The N.C. Department of Transportation and Georgia Department of Transportation have announced plans to study the nation's first interstate advanced air mobility (AAM) corridor. The project will connect Charlotte and Atlanta with a dedicated route for electric vertical takeoff and landing aircraft and uncrewed aerial systems.

Officials say the corridor will reduce congestion, improve travel times, and support economic growth while serving as a testbed for cleaner, smarter transportation. "This corridor is a launchpad for innovation," said Nick Short, director of the NCDOT Division of Aviation.

The project will coordinate with South Carolina to ensure regional integration and may expand around

airports and urban centers such as Greenville. Goals include accelerating safe use of AAM technology, fostering state collaboration, and ensuring equitable access to next-generation transportation.

## **Commissioner Causey urges Medicare** beneficiaries to check their options for 2025

RALEIGH — Insurance Commissioner Mike Causey reminds Medicare beneficiaries that it's time to compare

and evaluate their current plans and make necessary changes during the annual Open Enrollment Period.

"What worked for you this year may not be the best plan for you in 2025," Commissioner Causey said. "It is important to take advantage of the Open Enrollment Period by contacting local Seniors' Health Insurance Information Program (SHIIP) counselors to save money, improve your coverage or both."

The Open Enrollment Period begins on Oct. 15 and runs for eight weeks to give you enough time to review and make changes to your Medicare coverage. Changes must be made by Dec. 7 to guarantee your coverage will begin without interruption on Jan. 1, 2025.

It is important to contact your local SHIIP counselor before deciding about coverage for 2025. This may help you receive a more affordable and better Medicare health and/or drug plan in your area. For example, even if you are satisfied with your current Medicare Advantage or Part D plan, there may be another plan in your area that covers your health care and/or drugs at a better price.

SHIIP is a division of the North Carolina Department of Insurance and offers free, unbiased information about Medicare, Medicare prescription drug coverage, Medicare Advantage, long-term care insurance and other health insurance issues. SHIIP counselors can also help people find out if they are eligible for Medicare cost savings programs.
