NOTIFICATION OF DISCHARGE OF UNTREATED WASTEWATER

General Statute 143-215.1C requires that the owner or operator of any wastewater collection or treatment works to issue a press release when an untreated wastewater discharge of 1,000 gallons or more reaches surface waters.

In accordance with that regulation, the following news release has been prepared and issued to the media in the affected county:

The Town of Wadesboro had a discharge of untreated wastewater on August 18th, 2025 of an estimated 4,000 gallons at the Burns St. pump station, located at 396 Burns St., with an estimated 1,000 gallons reaching Lampley Branch in the Pee Dee River Basin.
