

# Anson and Chesterfield "Battle For The Border" Friday

The Anson High School Bearcats and Chesterfield Rams will face off on the gridiron for the third annual "Battle For The Border" contest on Friday, September 9. The winning team takes possession of a trophy presented by nonprofit hospices serving the two counties, Anson Community Hospice and Hospice of Chesterfield County.
