Story Time at the Partnership for Children is Back!

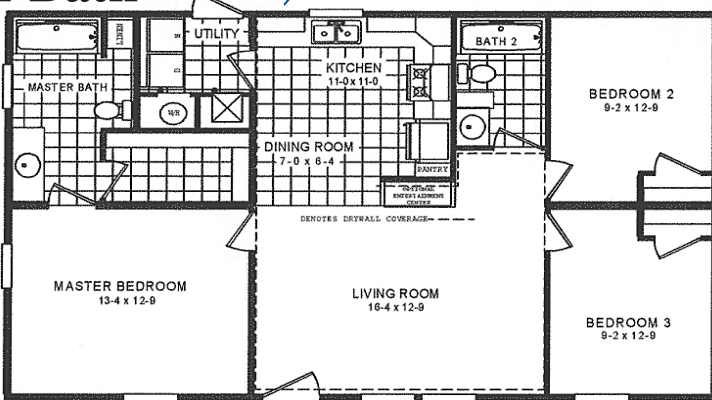
