Elaine launched the Barn Blast annual fundraiser, which became a vital source of funding for the Partnership and continues today as a beloved community tradition that reflects her vision and dedication.

Elaine often said she would retire as soon as she had grandchildren - and she

kept her word. When her first grandchild was announced, she announced her retirement; when he was born, she officially stepped away. By a remarkable coincidence - and perhaps a little divine timing - her retirement date fell on the very day her first grandchild, Holden, entered the world.

Family was the heart of Elaine's life. She is survived by her husband Donald Pope Scarborough, and their children, Whitney Thomas Scarborough Taylor (Jeremy) and Donald Logan Scarborough (Ashley); her beloved grandchildren: Holden Scarborough Taylor, Merritt Scarborough Taylor, Rivers Madalynn Scarborough, and Logan Craven Scarborough; her sister Gail Bartholomew Kiker of Pinehurst; her brother Thomas Alfred Bartholomew, Jr. (Ruth) of Raleigh; her brother-in-law Landon Alfred Scarborough, Jr. (Mickey); and nieces and nephews.
