Warehouse 2nd Shift Loader

Primary Responsibilities Include:

- Report to work on time daily.
- Perform a safety check on forklift. Report any hazards to supervisor immediately.
- · Stage material into racks as needed.
- · Maintain a safe and clean work area at all times. · Assemble and load material onto assigned truck.
- 1) Build and assemble product by customer using load sheets, and load and scan product onto truck to allow driving to unload assuring that material is correct and not damaged.
 - 2) Report any damage or material short to supervisor immediately.
 - 3) Check load sheet to make sure all materials are loaded.
 - 4) Check dock and staging area for any material that should be on the truck.
- 5) After completing load, take picture of load with route placard. · Check in any and all materials not loaded onto delivery trucks staging all will call, freight line
- and future delivery orders in the correct staging bins.

Report any material to supervisor that was left off any delivery trucks, or any overages shipped

- Check assigned staging bins for any old or unmarked material, and report to supervisor. • Check and sweep doc and all staging areas (including any aisles materials where placed from
- the transfer trucks).
- · Assist with loading will calls
- Pull material from staging or storage locations ensuring the customer receives the correct item, quantity and undamaged.
- Any other tasks assigned by supervisor.

Job Requirements:

Delivery Driver - Class CDL "A"

Primary Responsibilities Include:

- Primarily responsible for the condition of the truck and the contents within.
- Perform a pre-trip and post-trip daily ... documenting and reporting findings to the manager on duty ASAP and RTR, so arrangements can be made to correct the problem.
- Responsible for contacting the Manager on duty as early as possible when unable to work, so other arrangements can be made for coverage.
- Knowledgeable of multi routes and areas with the ability to read and understand maps.
- Train other drivers as needed.
- Keep all logs and driving reports up to date and accurate. · Make all deliveries on time and damage free.
- Treat each and every customer as they are the most important, maintaining good customer
- Report any problems, delays (in excess of 20 minutes) to the office ASAP.
- Re-secure the load as needed between stops.
- Pick up money and checks as directed on paperwork ... calling credit with any discrepancies. • Assist with truck routing to insure sequenced correctly.
- Ability to operate a forklift, with and without a carpet pole. • Pick up all returns, off load and placing in return bin.
- Fuel vehicle at the end of each trip.
- Complete daily paperwork and turn into shipping at the end of the shift.
- Attend all Safety and Staff meetings. • Must meet and follow all DOT requirements.
- · Adhere to all Company Policies and Procedures. • Wear complete CMH uniform & safety shoes.
- Maintain STOP / 3D / Forklift Certification Training.
- Strive for continuous job process improvements.
- Perform other work as directed by the Distribution and Shipping Manager.

- Class A CDL required, with at least 1 year experience. • Must have clean MVR and ability to pass DOT physical.
- · Excellent verifiable safety and attendance record.
- High school diploma or equivalent.
