This is one that goes back awhile, manufacturer in the world. Of course and one that has such diversity in the trucking industry.

Mr. Howard Lisk, Sr. worked for a number of years in road construction and trucking with Sikes Brothers Construction. However, in 1973 he began his business with two or three trucks - in fact, the "old" brown 1977 Ford was the third or fourth truck, and it was assigned to none other than son Howard, Jr. - he could not "wear it out," so this year it was taken out of service.

Howard, Sr. is mostly retired except "checking out the fishing" - and sons Howard, Jr., Jerry and Bruce are doing the work (they say!).

There are now 95 trucks in their fleet, which ranks them about 78th in the US in their type of product moved which is raw materials from origin to manufacturer. Some of the companies they work with are: Owens-Corning, Grace-Davidson, and Unimin Sand, Co., which incidentaly is the largest sand

there is Southern Products and Silica -Lisk, Inc. hauled their sand for them to destinations in "Bob Austin's" days!

There are many interesting aspects of Howard Lisk Trucking - I am told that since 1978 their office has been fully computerized with a very efficient office staff, that they have their own service department - all this and more at the terminal on Highway 742 north of

It has been my pleasure to letter their trucks, etc. since the beginning designing the first logo in the early 1970's, updating some later - but always hand lettering each one, until the mid-1990's, then they got so many trucks usually 25 at one order, and "my sign brushes got slower - and I, too, got slower" - well, using our style, they began to use


Mpact Football Team Recognized at Harvest Ministries
