Pope Francis Inspires Efforts to Increase Organ Donation

Pope Francis' visit to the United States has generated tremendous excitement and the momentum continues to build in anticipation of the arrival of His Holiness. From every corner of the country, including the Carolinas, Catholics and people of all faiths are inspired by the visit of Pope Francis and his support of organ, eye, and tissue donation.

As he met with the Transplant Committee for the Council of Europe in Rome last year, the Pope described the act of organ donation as a "testimony of love for our neighbor." A recent poll stated that nine out of 10 Catholics are in favor of Pope Francis and his teachings. In honor of the Pontiff's powerful message of charity and love, Life-Share Of The Carolinas urges Catholics and people of all religions who have not yet registered as an organ, eye, and tissue donor to do so.


