Division of Veterans Affairs Warns of Scams

The NC Division of Veterans Affairs (NCDVA) joins the NC Office of the Attorney General in warning veterans about scams observed here and across the nation regarding companies that require payment for processing of pension and other benefits forms.

"We have become aware of so-called 'pension poachers' who are targeting veterans through seminars and other seemingly innocent outreach," said Tim Wipperman, Assistant Secretary for Veterans Affairs. "This is an abhorrent practice and often includes questionable insurance or investment products. We are working with partner agencies to get the word out. There is no reason for a qualified veteran to pay a company to receive benefits they have earned through their service.

District Service Officers are available in all 100 counties to assist veterans with necessary paperwork. To find a local office, visit www.doa.nc.gov/vets/locations. In Anson County the Veteran Services Officer is Ted Ward. His office is located at 111 North Greene Street in Wadesboro in the former Belk building. 


