Deep Creek Baptist Church Health Fair is Saturday

Deep Creek Baptist Church will sponsor a Health Fair this Saturday, October 22, from 8 a.m. until 5 p.m. Free services such as blood pressure checks and flu immunizations will be offered. Pneumonia and Prevnar vaccinations will be offered if you have not had one in the last five years. Other offerings include tetanus (TD or TDAP) and shingles injections. Participants will need to bring Medicare or other insurance cards.

A Red Cross Blood Drive is scheduled from 10 a.m. until 2 p.m. at this event. Identification will need to be provided. If you are between the ages of 17 and 100 years old you may give blood, but you must weight at least 110 pounds. A mini physical will be given prior to donation that will include blood pressure, temperature and pulse checks. Sugar and cholesterol tests will be offered and a nutritionist or nurse will discuss your results with you.

Mammogram appointments can be made during the fair and scheduled at a local hospital. Experts will be available to give information on organ and bone marrow donations as well.

Directions to Deep Creek Baptist Church: Take Highway 109 South from Wadesboro. Deep Creek Road is on the left. After turning left travel approximately one mile, and you will see West Deep Creek Church on your left. The next road on your left is Beck Road.
