This year they are excited to welcome the expansion of Medicaid in North Carolina. NC Medicaid covers most health services -- including doctor visits, checkups, emergency care, hospital services, maternity and postpartum care, vision and hearing services, prescription drugs, behavioral health, preventative and wellness services, devices, and more.
