ECU's B. J. Tyson is Leading from the Bench

East Carolina University's leading scorer this season has yet to start a game. Freshman guard B. J. Tyson from Wadesboro is averaging 16 points on 48.2 percent shooting in 24.9 minutes per game, which ranks fourth on the team. B. J. earned American Athletic Conference Freshman of the Week honors last week after a pair of 20-point performances. He scored 22 in ECU's win over Fresno State and scored 24 on Hawaii the following night. 6-foot-3 Tyson enrolled at ECU last year but was not on the roster.

Don't Miss Your Layaway Deadline!

Layaway plans have made a comeback over the past couple of years because it is an affordable way for families to make small payments each month on holiday gifts. If you have gifts on layaway remember not to miss your final layaway payment and pickup deadline. December 15 is the deadline at Walmart for when you must pay the final balance on

your Christmas layaways and pick up your merchandise. If your layaway is at Toys R Us,

you have 90 days from the date you put items on layaway to pay for and pick up your purchases. K-Mart offered eight and 12 week layaway plans with deadlines that varied.

If you miss this deadline, the merchandise that you have on layaway will likely be returned to stock. Depending on the terms and conditions of your layaway plan, you may or may not be able to obtain a full refund of the money you have paid.


Tracking Santa around the World on Christmas Eve

Thanks to advances in technology, Santa can be tracked online as he travels around the world on Christmas Eve. If your children want to follow Santa's route, you can find many websites that will track his trek across the globe.

'Some of these websites are nice, but some are naughty, so it's important for parents to monitor your children's activities online," said Better Business Bureau President Tom Bartholomy.

The most popular Santa tracking website is NORAD with 22 million people following Santa's trip last Christmas Eve. NORAD has a new downloadable app to follow Santa on your smartphone or on Facebook, Twitter and Google+. NORAD has partnered with Microsoft to offer Santa tracking in 3-D this year.

"NORAD has also announced that Santa will be escorted by two fighter jets," said Bartholomy. "If children are concerned for Santa's safety, parents should be prepared to explain how the military escort makes his trip faster." Google also has a Santa tracker that uses Google Maps. 
