

While they have offered eBooks, digital audiobooks, and streaming video to the community through their partnership with OverDrive for four years, they know that many people are still surprised to learn their library card gives them access to over 4,700 free digital titles. There are never late fees with digital titles, as they return automatically at the end of the lending period. Readers can access the library's digital collection 24/7 by visiting srlsinfo.over-

drive.com or by downloading the Libby app from their device's app store.
