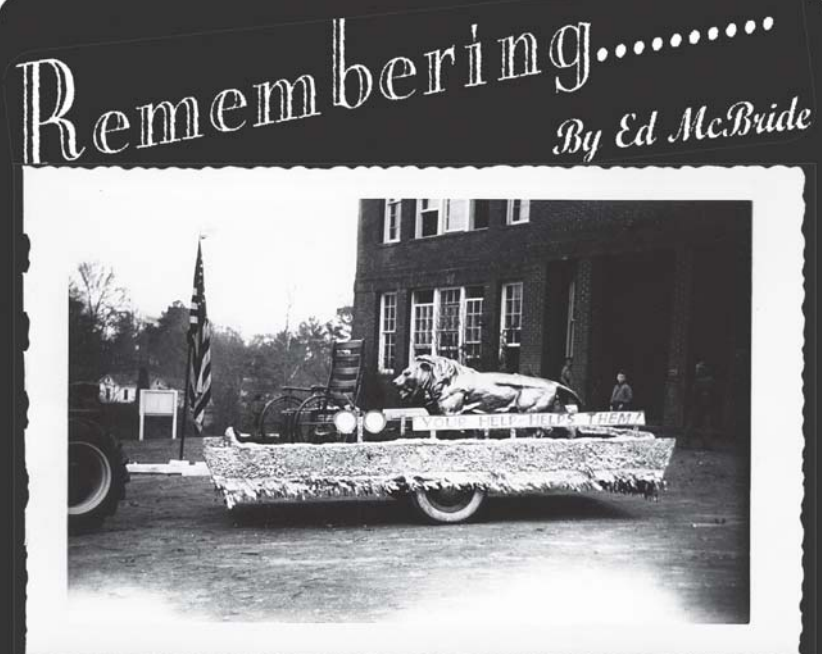

Do You Need a Coat or Blanket? Would You Like to Donate?

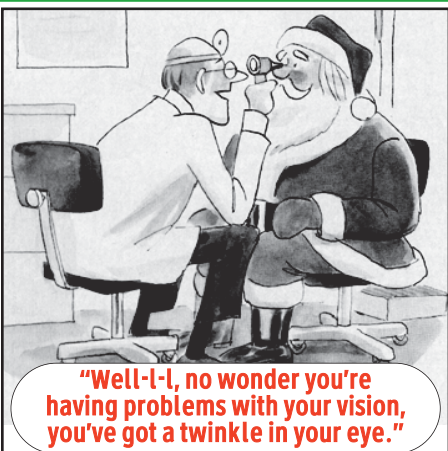

Lions Christmas Float

The float pictured above was a "homemade" float that was built by the Wadesboro Lions Club in 1952. It was built on a farm trailer and pulled by a "Bob Hurst" tractor from Early-Hurst Allis Chalmers. WADESBORO LEAF COLLECTION

Fall has arrived and the Town of Wadesboro has started the annual collection of leaves. The Town's leaf collection equipment will only pick up leaves and pine straw. Please keep this in mind when putting your leaves out to be picked up. Do not mix any objects such as limbs, bricks, rocks or building debris with the leaves. Town employees can be seriously injured and equipment can be damaged by objects mixed with the leaves. Please place these items in separate piles for collection. Mixed debris in with the leaves will not be picked up. The leaf truck follows the same route as the garbage truck follows. Please be patient, as it usually takes approximately two weeks to complete the entire town once. When the leaves really begin to fall, it will take even longer to complete the routes. Remember to have all of your leaves out for pickup before February 1. Leaf collection will stop on this date. For more information contact Hugh James, Public Works Director (704) 694-5171.



WADESBORO TREE TRIMMING & LIMB REMOVAL GUIDELINES

The Town of Wadesboro provides the service to collect and dispose of tree trimmings and limb removal to the citizens of Wadesboro. The following rules apply:

- The service is intended for homeowners who trim trees and shrubbery on their property by the homeowner. The service is NOT intended for home owners that hire tree surgeons, contractors, etc. to cut trees/limbs and cuttings.
- The Town will NOT remove trees/limbs, etc. from lot clearing operations.
- Please limit the size of limbs to four inches in diameter and six feet long.
- Place the debris near the street, away from power poles or other obstacles. Do not place limbs in the ditches. Do not place debris where it blocks the view of traffic.
