Judge Mills opened the session by revealing he was sworn in exactly 50 years ago in September, and remarked that this was a momentous occasion for a new attorney. Fred Poisson, Jr. then introduced Flinchum and her family to the court, and expressed his personal knowledge of her "compassion" and "integrity." Flinchum's parents held her grandmother's family Bible as the Oath of Office was administered.

At the conclusion of

the ceremony Flinchum was presented with a mayoral proclamation honoring her accomplishments by her uncle and godfather, Dan Pugh, mayor of Lewisville, NC.

Ms. Flinchum graduated from Anson High School in 2003, obtained her bachelor degree from Campbell University in 2007, and, graduated from North Carolina Central University School of Law with her juris doctor degree on May 14, 2011. During law school she met Chief Justice John Roberts of the United States Supreme Court as well as numerous state and federal officials through her active involvement in a mentorship program. She completed the necessary training to become a certified Superior Court Mediator, and worked with an alternative dispute resolution clinic mediating cases for Wake County. She also worked as a research assistant on a year-long project exploring social media's impact on global conflict resolution.

Flinchum is the daughter of Bert and Martha Flinchum of Wadesboro, granddaughter of Fredericka Clarkson of Wadesboro, and Eva Flinchum of Pfafftown, NC and the sister of William "Matt" Flinchum of Apex, NC and Caroline Imler of Louisville, KY. She is pictured above with her parents.
