

American Red Cross Lifeguarding Course Offered at Little Park

Anson County Parks and Recreation will offer the American Red Cross Lifeguarding Course on April 26 to 28 and May 3 and 5. Friday, 5 p.m., Saturday, 9 a.m. and Sunday, 1 p.m. The class will be held at the Anson County Parks and Recreation Pool in Wadesboro. CPR/AED/First Aid Renewal will be taught on Friday May 3 starting at 5 p.m. The deadline to enroll will be Friday April 19.

To be eligible for the Lifeguarding course the participant must be 15 years of age on or before the final scheduled session of this course. The participant must successfully complete the following:

- 1) Swim 300 yards continuously, using these strokes:
 - The 300 yards may be a combination of front crawl and breaststroke
 - The front crawl and breaststroke must use rhythmic breathing.
- 2) Starting in the water, swim 20 yards using front crawl or breaststroke, surface dive 7-10 feet, retrieve a 10-pound object, return to the surface, swim 20 yards back to the starting point with the object and exit the water using a ladder or steps, within 1 minute, 40 seconds.
- 3) Tread water for 2 minutes while arms crossed and hands under armpits.

Red Cross Water Safety Instructor Course

Anson County Parks and Recreation will offer the American Red Cross Water Safety Instructor Course. Classes will be held on Friday, May 17 at 5 p.m., Saturday, May 18 at 9 a.m. and Sunday, May 19 at 1 p.m. Saturdays will be cancelled as needed and the deadline to enroll is Friday, May 3.

The purpose of the course is to train instructor candidates to teach water safety, including the Basic Water Rescue course, six levels of the Learn-to-Swim and Parent and Child Aquatics. Participants must be at least 16 years of age by the last scheduled session of the instructor course and be able to demonstrate the following skills - Swim the following strokes with American Red Cross Learn-to-Swim Level 4 Stroke Performance criteria:

- Front crawl - 25 yards
- Back crawl - 25 yards
- Breaststroke - 25 yards
- Elementary backstroke - 25 yards
- Sidestroke - 25 yards
- Butterfly - 15 yards
- Maintain position on stroke 1 minute in deep water (floating or sculling).
- Tread water for 1 minute.

The Anson County Board of Commissioners will receive proposals for the Runway 34 Tree Obstruction Removal project in the Construction Room of the Airport Terminal Building at the Anson County Airport, 3154 Airport Road, Wadesboro, NC 28170, until Tuesday, April 23, 2013 at 2:00 p.m., at which time and place all proposals received will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids received after the stated time will not be accepted.

Work shall consist of clearing and grubbing and fencing at the Anson County Airport. Work shall include, but is not limited to, clearing and grubbing, demolition of existing fence, installation of new fence, implementation of temporary sediment basins and other erosion and sediment control features, and other incidental items necessary to complete the project.

Bid security in the form of a bid bond equal to 5% of the total bid is required. Contract security in the form of 100% Performance and Payment Bonds will be required.

No bid may be withdrawn after closing time for the receipt of proposals for a period of ninety (90) calendar days.

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held in the Conference Room of the Airport Terminal Building at the Anson County Airport on Tuesday, April 16, 2013, at 1:00 p.m. The purpose of this meeting will be to familiarize the prospective bidders with the proposed project, and the surrounding construction program. The meeting will cover contract scope, Bid items, schedule requirements, and any questions from those in attendance. A representative of the airport and the Engineer will be on hand to respond to questions from potential Bidders in attendance.
